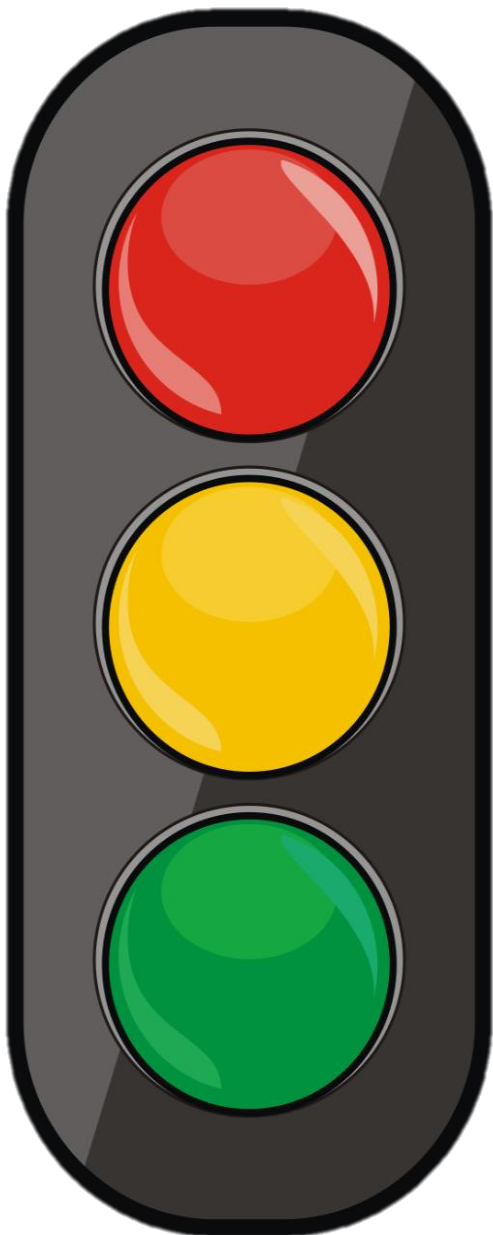

Unkindness and Bullying What happens if you get it wrong?



Stage 3

You have chosen to carry on with the behaviour for which you were given a yellow card.

THIS IS VERY SERIOUS

What happens?

Your parents will be told. Together, you and your parents will meet with Mrs Bradbury and Mr Page.

Your parents will be shown a record of your behaviour. Mrs Bradbury will seriously consider how best to support and protect all pupils involved.

Stage 2

You have repeated behaviour for which you were given a green card, or you have been so unkind that Mrs Bradbury feels you should be fast tracked to Stage 2.

What happens?

Separately, you and your parents will meet with Mr Page and Mrs Bradbury and will discuss ways to help you from continuing to hurt or be unkind to others.

Choose to change your behaviour

Stage 1

You have been unkind to someone regularly and it could be said that you are bullying them.

What happens?

Meet with Mr Page or Miss Lee and talk about your behaviour. You will have a note in your planner and a teacher will talk to your parents. You might be put on a target card to help you think about how you are behaving.

Remember the Oakwood Way:

We think about other people's feelings
