

APPENDIX G

Science Marking Guidelines

For each piece of work the children have a Learning Objective (LO). When they have completed the work it will be marked. On the marking the teacher will identify whether the child has met the learning objective or not.

This what the teacher markings next to the Learning Objective mean:

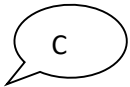
- (nm) = You have tried but not met the LO.
- (pm) = You have tried and partly met the LO.
- (ma) = You have tried and met the LO with some help.
- (m) = You have worked hard and met the LO.

The teacher will also identify how the children have performed in their work by using ink stamps or a speech bubble.

This is what the teacher markings on your work mean:



I have discussed your work with you.



We have discussed the work as a class together.



A good try. Now try to expand your ideas.



A good effort. You are working well. Well done!



An excellent effort. You are working really hard. Well done!
